# Goals and Objectives

2007 – 2009

## **Goal 1: PROVIDE THE HIGHEST QUALITY LEARNING EXPERIENCES IN ORDER TO INCREASE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT**

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- Obj 1.1* Beginning in February 2008, 100% of teachers recommended for permanent status will be NCLB compliant, and the District will annually increase the number of teachers who hold English Learner authorization.
- Obj 1.2* The District will conduct an annual needs assessment to determine the types and levels of professional development activities to include the appropriate use of instructional technology needed by certificated administrators, teachers, classroom instructional assistants, and substitute teachers.
- Obj 1.3* The District will create and maintain an annual calendar, which specifies professional development opportunities for certificated and classified employees, maximizing our current and future technology.
- Obj 1.4* By the first day of the school year, the District will have filled 95% of school principal and assistant principal positions. By the first day of the school year, the District will have filled 95% of teacher positions.
- Obj 1.5* The District will establish pacing guides, benchmarks, and end-of-year assessments for the four core academic areas in K-6.
- Obj 1.6* Pacing guides, benchmarks, and, end-of-course assessments for all a-g requirements in math, English language arts, science and social science will be created.
- Obj 1.7* The District will continue working toward ensuring that all students will score at the proficient level on CST's by 2012.
- Obj 1.8* The District will continue to increase the number of English Learner students being redesignated each year.
- Obj 1.9* The number of students passing the CAHSEE at the initial administration will increase each year.
- Obj 1.10* The number of students taking Advanced Placement courses will increase annually.
- Obj 1.11* The District will create and implement a district-wide K-12 Visual and Performing Arts Plan.

## **Goal 2: PROMOTE SAFETY AND WELLNESS**

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- Obj 2.1* The District and school sites will review and update school safety plans annually, ensuring there is an appropriate number of security personnel.
- Obj 2.2* By June 2008, a consistent standards-aligned physical education program will be implemented at all schools.
- Obj 2.3* Beginning in June 2008, the District will annually review and revise as necessary its emergency preparedness plan.

### **Goal 3: COMMUNICATE EFFECTIVELY AND EFFICIENTLY**

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- Obj. 3.1* The District will establish a walk-in Parent Resource Center to provide information on District schools and programs.
- Obj. 3.2* The District's cable channel will offer a variety of instructional and informative programs.
- Obj. 3.3* All students who are at risk of not graduating with their class, along with their parents, will be informed by site personnel of the student's status at each grading period, beginning with the first progress report of each school year.
- Obj. 3.4* Human Resources will maintain and update its web page to include such information as contacts, resources, descriptions of services, and credentialing information; provide electronic links to EdJoin; and continue to maintain information presently on the web page, i.e., collective bargaining agreements and salary schedules.
- Obj. 3.5* The District will ensure multiple methods for staff to provide progress information and grades to parents and students.

### **Goal 4: UTILIZE APPROPRIATE TECHNOLOGY THAT ENHANCES TEACHING, LEARNING, AND PRODUCTIVITY**

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- Obj. 4.1* By June 2009, 75% of teachers and 100% of administrators will be trained in Edusoft and Data Director software programs to generate student achievement data to inform instructional decisions.

### **Goal 5: ASSURE FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY**

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- Obj. 5.1* The District will align all budgets annually, incorporating new funding sources, to the Strategic Plan, Board goals, and student learning needs.
- Obj. 5.2* The District will receive Positive Certification on all Interim Budgets adopted by the Board.
- Obj. 5.3* The District will receive unqualified annual audit reports.

### **Goal 6: PROVIDE FACILITIES THAT SUPPORT TEACHING, LEARNING, AND PRODUCTIVITY**

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- Obj. 6.1* The District will review and revise attendance boundaries as necessary.
- Obj. 6.2* The District will create and implement a multi-year equipment replacement schedule.
- Obj. 6.3* The District will complete a district-wide facilities master plan.
